

Farley House Transitional Residence

Intake Criteria (Families): Please have the following:

- Be an unaccompanied female 18 years of age or older with a maximum of two minor children under 17 years of age (can be 18 if still in High School).
- Meet the HUD definition of homelessness.
- Must be income eligible according to HUD's income limits guideline.
- If a former resident, applicant may not have resided at Good Shepherd Center during the previous three years, and never have been evicted from Good Shepherd Center in the past.
- Have a current TB test for all household members (taken within the past six months) school aged children only.
- Have a valid picture ID and Social Security Card (if applicable), Birth Certificate and Social Security Card for all children.
- Current Immunization records for all children.
- Be prepared to have security deposit (\$500) and utility deposit (varies).
- Pay a monthly rental fee of 30% of their adjusted gross income.

Intake Process:

- Our referral application and certification of homelessness needs to be submitted by the applicant's case manager or service provider working with the applicant in any capacity.
- Submit applicant's three most recent paystubs, picture identification and bank statements (six months), including assets.
- All forms may be emailed to: intakes@gschomeless.org.
- Once submitted, the status of the application will be communicated through the applicant's referring party.

Residents are encouraged to:

- Participate in a monthly savings program towards their permanent housing.
- Engage in case management services on site.
- Participate in Life Skills workshops, including parenting classes.
